



CVGPC Conduct

Our ability to host events at these facilities depends upon the conduct of the students, staff, spectators, and support personnel participating in these events. Please remember, directors and staff are responsible for the behavior of their participants and parent organization/volunteers at all CVGPC contest sites. Instruction regarding proper conduct of expectations should be a part of the overall educational and preparation process. It is crucial that CVGPC can confidently host events in these facilities without fear of damage to the buildings, disrespect for their property, or other inappropriate behavior.

We reserve the right to ask any person at these events to leave the premises in the event of inappropriate behavior, including mistreatment of CVGPC Staff, VIP, and Executive Board personnel. Name calling and foul language will be cause to remove someone from an event. If the person chooses not to leave, local authorities will be contacted.

At no time, should anyone other than the CVGPC Staff or Board Members approach any member of our adjudication panels with comments or concerns. Contact CVGPC Staff or Board Member with concerns.

Spectator Wristband Policy

1. Spectators **MUST HAVE** wristbands properly secured on their wrists **PRIOR** to entering the Spectator Entrance, Performer Re-Admit Entrance, or Performance Entrance (if helping a unit enter the competition floor).
 - I. If a Spectator removes their wristband, or does not have one, the spectator will be asked to leave the event facility until wristband is properly secured and presented.
 - II. CVGPC Staff will periodically check persons for wristbands throughout the show when needed, please make sure your wristband is visible during these checks.
2. **NO** spectators are allowed to enter the Performance Entrance unless they are with the group performing. No spectators are allowed through the Performance Exit.
3. The CVGPC will **NOT** replace any ripped or lost wristbands, **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
4. The CVGPC does **NOT REFUND** any admissions costs, **NO EXCEPTIONS**.

Attending CVGPC Contests without paying admission only hurts the young participants of the circuit. The CVGPC uses these funds to secure facilities and organize our contests, provide quality adjudication to help your child become a better musician and performer, and provide an overall great experience for everyone! At the end of each season, the CVGPC gives most of our proceeds to our hosting schools and programs.
